Matrimonial Property Regime (<i>Adjustments of estate at end of marriage</i>)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Statutory Matrimonial Property Regime of Community of Accrued Gains , that means that irrespective of the marriage ending by death <u>or</u> divorce, an equal contribution of surpluses gained during the time of marriage will take place.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Separation of Property , that means general exclusion of equalization of surpluses (that means in each case the marriage ends – death <u>or</u> divorce)	
<input type="checkbox"/> Amendment of Statutory Matrimonial Property Regime , as following:	
<input type="checkbox"/> exclusion of the equalization of accrued gains <u>only</u> in case of divorce (<i>advantage compared to traditional separation of property: if marriage ends through death, the equal contribution of surpluses will be free of inheritance tax</i>)	
<input type="checkbox"/> excluding following objects from the calculation of surpluses (e.g. entrepreneurial participation real estate):	
<input type="checkbox"/> regulations on the equalization amount of surpluses (e.g. agreements on maximum limits, establishment of compensatory amount, agreement on compensation payments, etc.)

Postmarital Maintenance (<i>Mutual Maintenance Obligation of Spouses after Divorce</i>)	
<input type="checkbox"/> according to the Legal Regulation , which states that each spouse is responsible for themselves after a divorce, unless there are certain circumstances (such as children, age, illness, etc.) which grant maintenance	
<input type="checkbox"/> Relinquishment of certain maintenance claims (e.g. due to age, etc.)	
<input type="checkbox"/> agreement on duration of the maintenance obligation	
<input type="checkbox"/> agreement on the amount of the maintenance	

Pension Rights Equalization (<i>Division of Pension Rights gained during Marriage</i>)	
<input type="checkbox"/> according to the Legal Regulation , which states that pension entitlements gained during marriage have to be shared in case of a divorce	
<input type="checkbox"/> Complete Exclusion of the pension rights equalization
